## Perspective

**Government of India** has taken a series of initiatives to improve Occupational Safety & Health Management System in industry and to match the Standards in the country with the latest in the world.

ILO has also associated actively with National Initiative on Eradication of HIV/AIDS. SCOPE being Public Sector Employers Organisation is a signatory to the Statement of Commitment on HIV/AIDS.

### WHO Global Plan of Action 2008-2017

- The health of workers is an essential prerequisite for productivity and economic development,
- There are major gaps between and within countries in the exposure of workers and local communities to occupational hazards and in their access to occupational health services;
- The measures to establish and strengthen core institutional capacities and human resource capabilities for dealing with the special health needs of working populations and to generate evidence on workers' health and translate that evidence into policy and actions.

**Working group of Indian Planning Commission**, in its Report for the Tenth 5-year Plan had suggested, Training for strengthening and development of Standard Work procedure for safe work practices. For this purpose a specific Programme has been developed focused on this theme for sharing of good practices, by pooling of resources amongst CPSEs, and for standardization of procedures.

This programme will provide opportunities for exchange of experiences and innovative practices amongst Technology Experts, Industry Experts and Experts from Regulatory bodies for in depth understanding of the key issues for successful implementation.
